- \checkmark Safety Harness is a vital piece of equipment used when working at heights. It is a fall-arrest system designed to reduce the impact of a fall, however as it is made from webbing it is common for its fibers to degrade.
- \checkmark Any damage to the safety harness can hugely impact the strength and effectiveness of the harness, which can put those using it at a greater
- ✓ The Personal Protective equipment at Work Regulations 1992 and the Work at Height Regulations 2005 both provide guidelines on the use and safety of a harness.
